Introduction

The OPTN Ad Hoc Disease Transmission Advisory Committee (the Committee) met via WebEx on 07/01/2023 to discuss the following agenda items:

- 2. Review & Vote: Summary of Current Evidence and Information- Mpox in Donor Screening and Transplantation

1. Review & Vote: Summary of Evidence on SARS-CoV-2

The Committee reviewed updates to the SARS-CoV-2 Summary of Evidence (SOE) document. These updates were developed in collaboration with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and are reviewed and revised annually or as needed.

The purpose of the SOE document is to serve as a resource for the community. The recent changes were non-substantive and focused on improving the accuracy and relevance of the literature cited, consolidating information, and enhancing readability. Updates included:

- Streamlining content for clarity and conciseness
- Incorporating analysis and studies referenced in the document
- Updating hyperlinks
- Simplifying language to improve overall accessibility
