OPTN Modernization Initiative


The OPTN Modernization Initiative is centered on putting patients first, prioritizing information flow to clinicians, promoting innovation, and enhancing transparency and accountability.

Modernization Next Steps

- Select an interim OPTN Executive Director
- Award a Board Support contract in Fall 2024
 - Recruit a new OPTN Executive Director
 - Develop a new process and hold a special election for OPTN Board members
 - Review of governance structure, bylaws and policies
- Award Transition Operations contracts in Fall 2024
 - Continue to support access to transplant
 - Document and propose improvements to operations and processes (Patient Safety/MPSC, Finance, IT systems, Organ Tracking)
 - Begin data and system discovery and documentation efforts

Data Directive Status





Pre-Waitlist: Referral and Evaluation Registration Forms (RERF)

Goal: Address inequities in access to transplantation and substantial variation in practice across transplant programs with respect to transplant access.



Form 1: For Referral

Demographics, Contact Information, OPTN Patient ID, Financial Resources Referral Date, Provider, Status

Form 2: For Evaluation

Demographics, Contact Information, OPTN Patient ID, Financial Resources Patient Measurements, Evaluation Details





Ventilated Patient Form (VPF)

Goal: To better support the CMS Condition for Coverage that requires OPOs to report certain data on potential deceased donors and improve access to transplant.

The VPF now integrates additional patient- and family-focused OPO processes, including:

- 1. Modality of first approach
- 2. Language of first approach
- 3. Interpreter for approach

Data fields have been further refined to <u>reduce burden</u> and <u>improve</u> <u>integration</u> with information OPOs currently collect in DonorNet and OPO EMRs.





Public Comment Schedule



- New data collection forms will be going to the federal register for 60-day public comment this Fall
- After compiling feedback, HRSA will make revisions and put a revised form out for 30-days
- Upon approval the OPTN will begin outreach and implementation with the community





Revisions to Membership Application & Requirements





Comprehensive Review of OPTN Membership Policies

- The OPTN Modernization Initiative calls for a comprehensive review of OPTN policies and practices to ensure they are patient-centered and advance equity, transparency, and accountability.
 - HRSA appreciates the MPSC and collaborating committees' efforts and would like to strengthen these efforts with additional expert support to take a holistic review of membership requirements.
