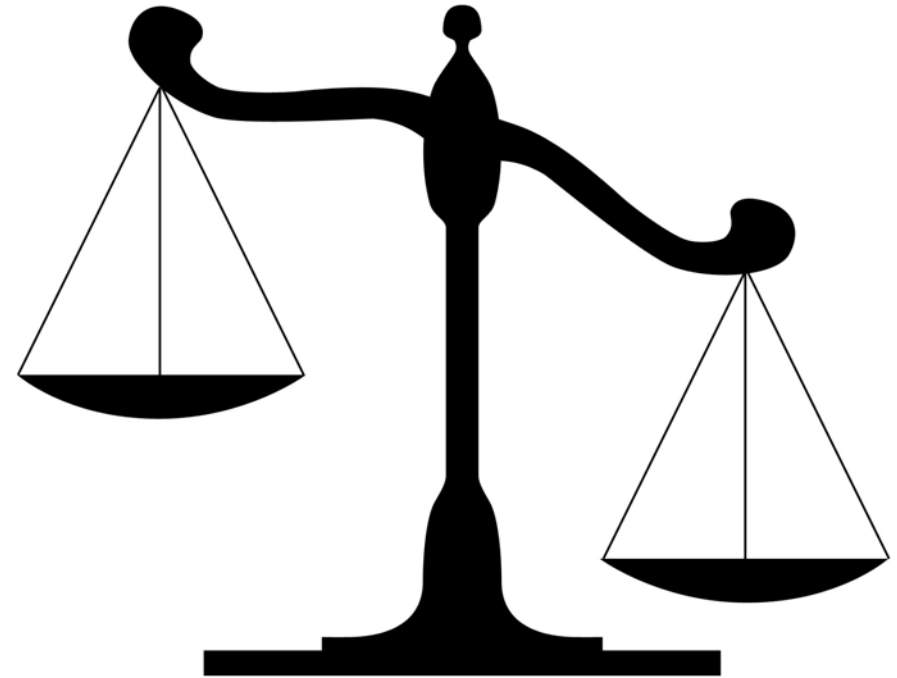

The Policy Oversight Committee helps balance committee work

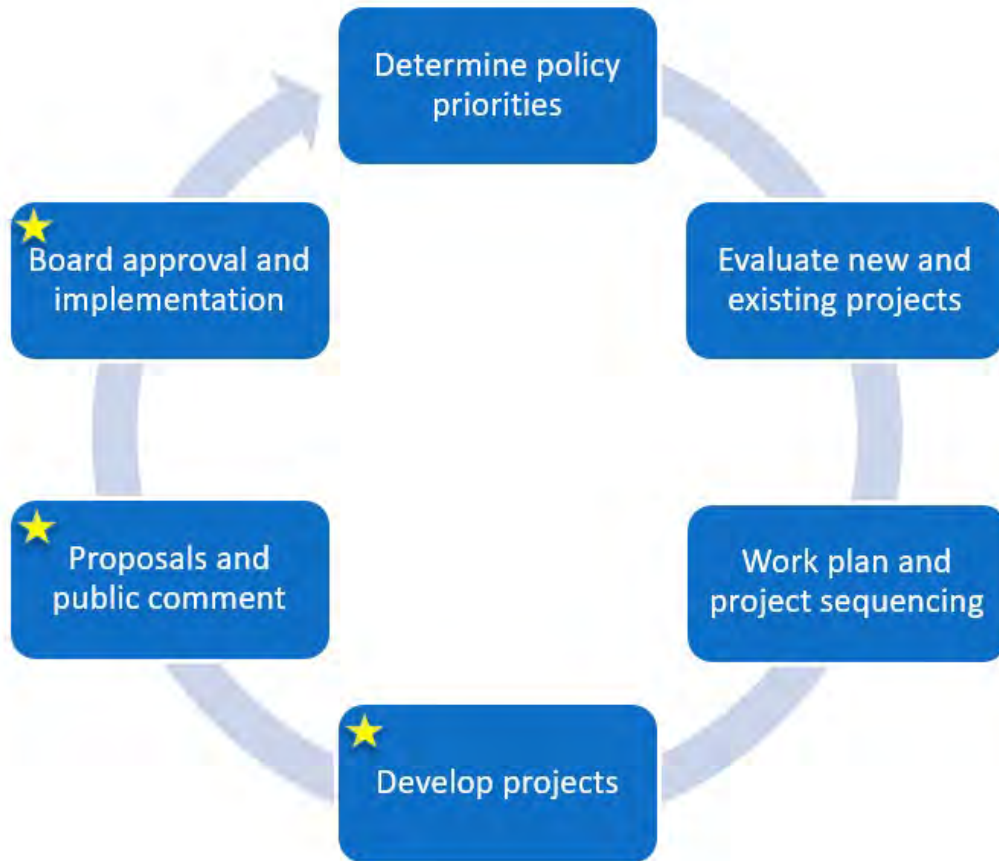
- Identifies areas for coordination

Project Approval

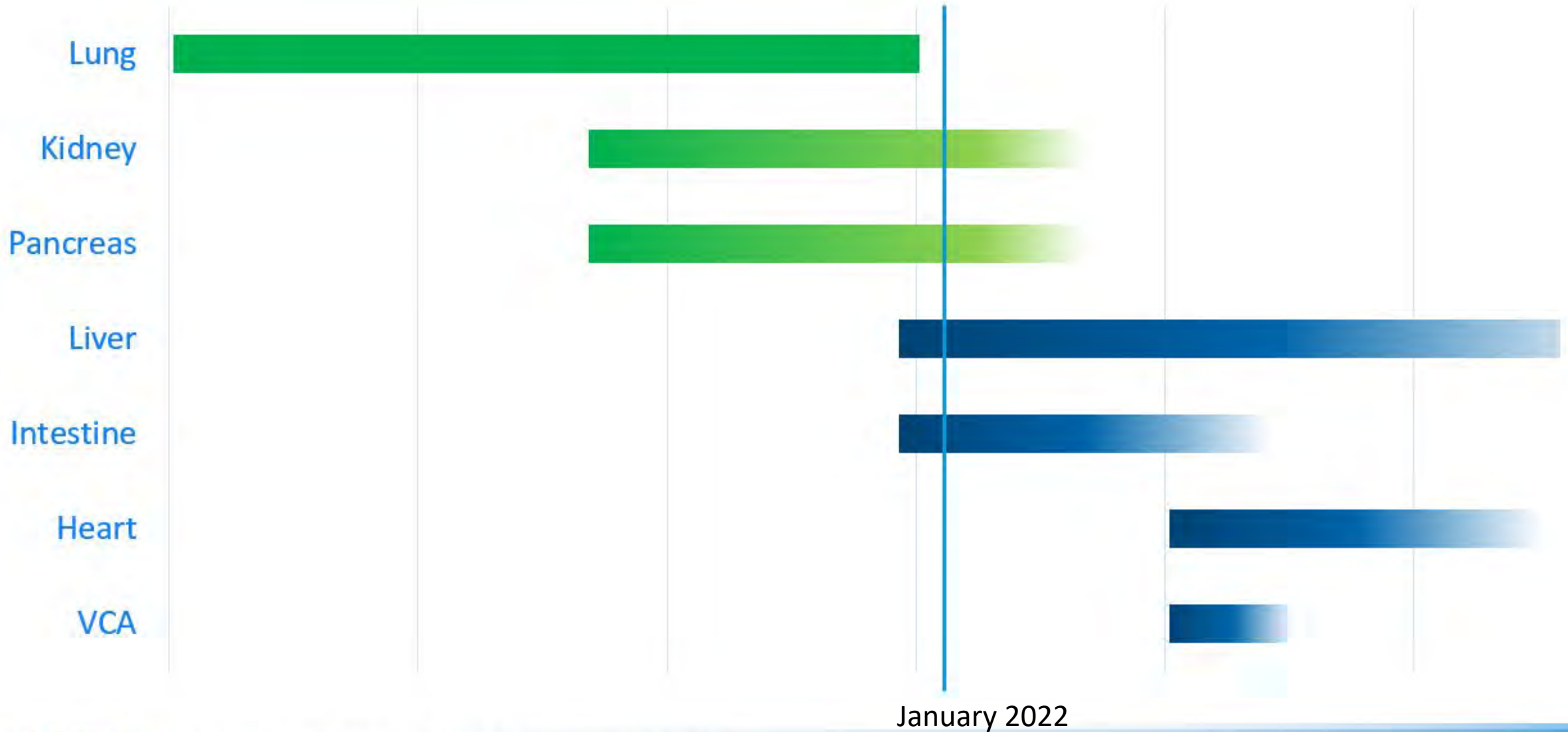
- Alignment with broader OPTN goals

Strategic Policy Priorities

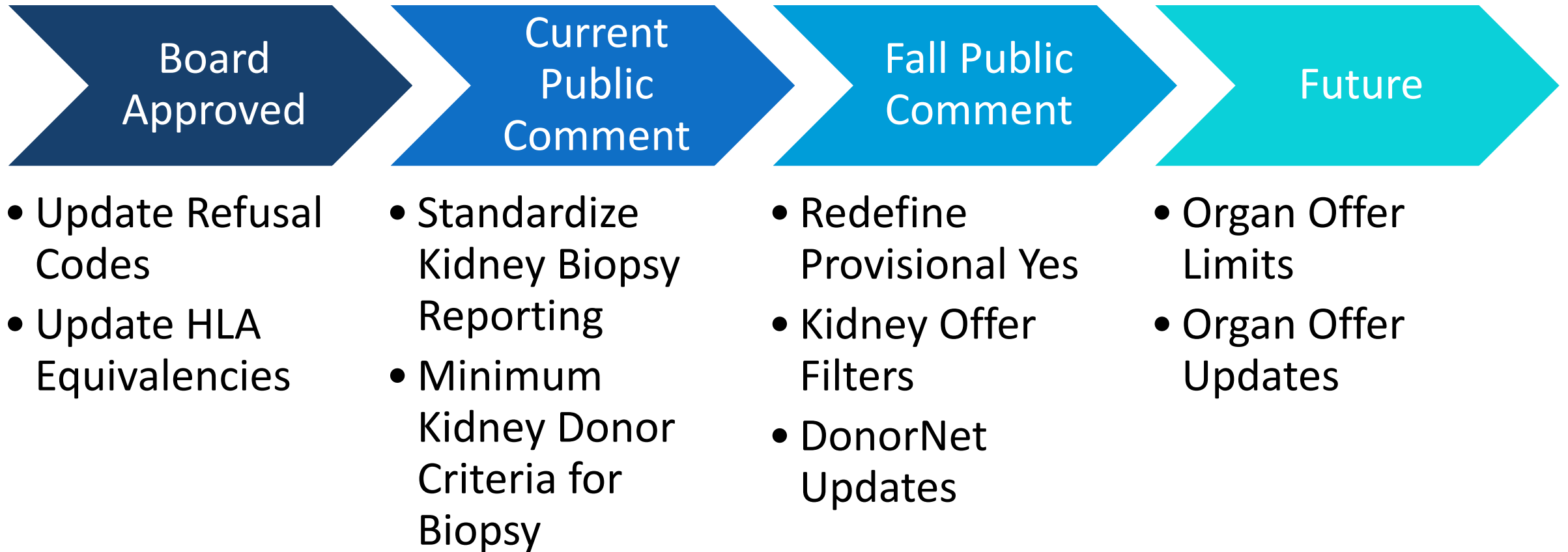


- Continuous distribution

- Improved equity for multiorgan and single organ candidates

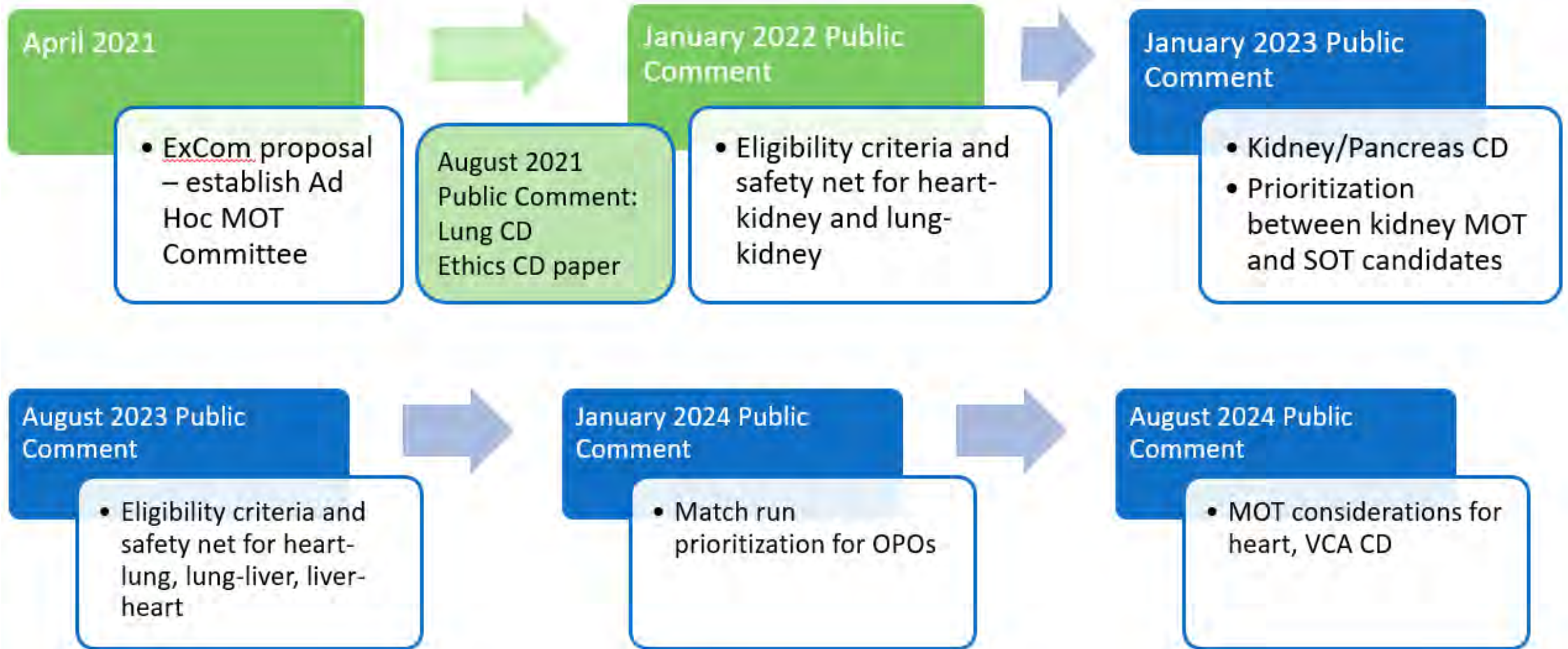
Continuous Distribution Sequence

Policy Oversight Improvements

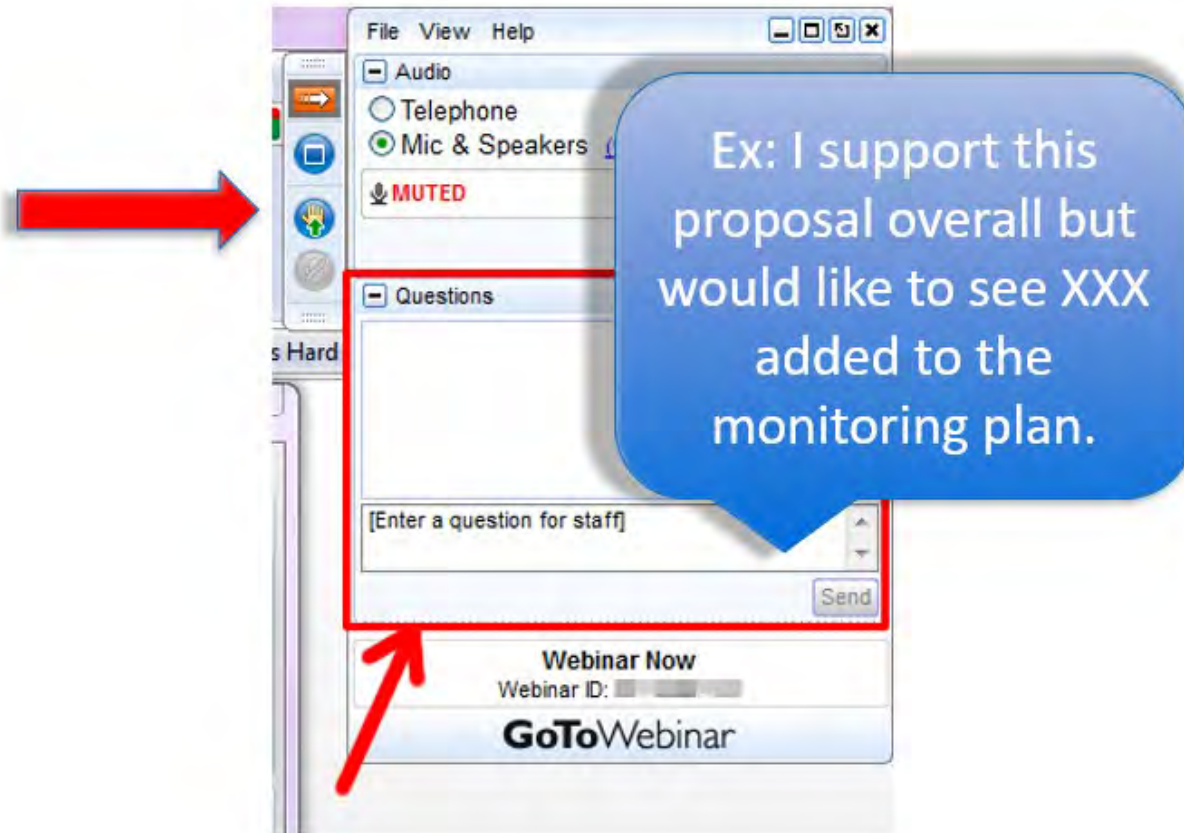
- Working to define project benefit and develop a method to rate various project attributes
